**No Stallions in Youth Classes**

**Federal Law states that any horse found to be sore can't participate in any horse show. Any horse determined to be sore by the judge or ring master will not be allowed to show. All horses are subject to being inspected or checked by the ring master.**

**ALL RIDERS UNDER 18 MUST WEAR HELMET IN SPEED EVENTS.**

**Other classes will be added by request for five or more riders.**

**Youth riders must have a waiver signed by their parents.**

**Registration will be done 6 classes prior to class shown in.**

**Gate call will be 2 minutes and then closed with no refunds.**

**Light Shod Definition - 3/8 by 1" or smaller**

**Heavy shod definition - 1/2" by 1" or larger**

**SPECTATORS AND PARTICIPANTS ENTER THE SHOW GROUNDS AT THEIR OWN RISK.**

**TN Equine Law does not protect riders beyond show ground gates.**

**Current Negative Coggins (12 month) required on all equines at show.**

**All horses shown must be fit and clean and healthy.**

**Stalls and Hookups available if necessary \$20 per night**
